

REQUIRED DATA ELEMENTS
For Completing the Preliminary Estimate of State Aid Template
School Years 2016-17 & Beyond

Student Count Data:

1. COPIES OF Tables I, II, III, and IV from the district's student attendance accounting software package (NOT a PEIMS Report(s)) for school year 2016-17 printed in the aggregate for the DISTRICT, not campus by campus (a.k.a., the superintendent's semester report summarizing the data from all campuses for the 1st semester. (EXAMPLE: For TxEIS/RSCCC software, these are reports SAT 0900 and SAT 2100)
2. From the district's national school lunch program reports, copies of each report for the months of October 2015 - September 2016 that show the number of students approved for free and reduced lunch each month, NOT the number of meals prepared, served, or reimbursed.

Property Value Data:

3. A copy of the most recently released property value study report from the county appraisal district (CAD) showing the 2016 CERTIFIED taxable value (FREEZE ADJUSTED for the residential property plus the mineral value, if the two are not combined into one total) and the dollar amount of taxes to be collected on the property on which values are frozen for school year 2016-17 as released on or about July 25, 2016 and updated after the appraisal review board (ARB) hearings. NOTE: If the school district is served by more than one CAD, this information is needed from each CAD.

Tax Collection Data:

4. The district's adopted M&O and I&S tax rates for school years 2014-15, 2015-16, & 2016-17.
5. The budgeted M&O and I&S tax collections for school year 16-17.
6. A copy of the most recently received tax collection report for the period July 1 or September 1, 2016 (depending upon the district's fiscal year start date) to the present.

Other Data:

7. A copy of the district's **most current** bond payment schedule(s), if applicable.

Additional Data Requirements for Chapter 41 Districts:

8. For school year 2015-16 & 2016-17, the number of non-resident students that are charged tuition, if any, and the amount of tuition that each student is charged.
9. The actual cost being paid to the County Appraisal District(s) for school year 2016-17 that was reported to TEA in January 2017 for appraisal services ONLY.
10. The number of resident students being educated by another district for which tuition is paid, and the dollar amount paid per student in each case, if any for both school years 2015-16 and 2016-17.
